NEED FOR ATTENTION OR POTTY BREAKS

BARKING CAN ALSO SIGNAL A DOG'S NEED FOR ATTENTION, FOOD, WATER, OR BATHROOM BREAKS. PUPPIES AND ADULT DOGS ALIKE MAY VOCALIZE TO COMMUNICATE IMMEDIATE NEEDS, ESPECIALLY IF CRATE TIME IS PROLONGED WITHOUT REGULAR BREAKS. UNDERSTANDING THESE SIGNALS HELPS OWNERS RESPOND APPROPRIATELY AND MAINTAIN THE DOG'S WELL-BEING.
