She and her four children came in, and picked out their own full wardrobes. They left without having to pay one cent, which I doubt they had anyway. That month, and every month, I gave away \$44,000 in free clothing, and made \$5,000 for myself in the process. I only ran the business for four months because I'm a business writer, not a 'clothing exchange guy,' but I did have fun while the experiment lasted. There is room for at least one free clothing exchange in every community in the world. If that doesn't float your boat, read on, because I'll talk about all sorts of creative ideas from custom tailoring to eBay sales. You may want to read the book in sequence, even if some of these ideas aren't for you, because in each section, you will find many useful and effective business tips you can use in whatever business you take up.
