He not only worked hard and became an outstanding lawyer, but reached the pinnacle of judiciary—and became the first Black man in Oklahoma to do so. Just like Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher, Tom refused the "basement," and that noble resistance led him all the way to the second floor of the Oklahoma State Capitol.
