INDIANA ARCHITECT LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

THE INDIANA ARCHITECT LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS ARE ESTABLISHED BY THE INDIANA PROFESSIONAL LICENSING AGENCY (IPLA) AND THE INDIANA ARCHITECTS BOARD TO ENSURE THAT LICENSED ARCHITECTS MAINTAIN PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS. RENEWAL IS MANDATORY BIENNIALLY, AND ARCHITECTS MUST FULFILL SPECIFIC CRITERIA TO RETAIN THEIR LICENSURE STATUS. THESE REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE COMPLETING CONTINUING EDUCATION, SUBMITTING A RENEWAL APPLICATION, AND PAYING THE APPLICABLE FEES.

LICENSE RENEWAL PERIOD AND DEADLINES

Architect licenses in Indiana expire every two years on December 31 of even-numbered years. Licensees are responsible for renewing their license prior to this expiration date to avoid any disruption in their ability to practice. The renewal window typically opens 90 days before the expiration date, allowing sufficient time for completion of all renewal obligations.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR RENEWAL

To be eligible for license renewal, architects must hold an active license in good standing and meet all continuing education requirements. CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS CAN BE EARNED THROUGH VARIOUS APPROVED ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING:

- ATTENDING SEMINARS, WORKSHOPS, AND CONFERENCES RELATED TO ARCHITECTURE
- COMPLETING ACCREDITED ONLINE COURSES OR WEBINARS
- PARTICIPATING IN TEACHING OR PRESENTING ARCHITECTURAL SUBJECTS
- Publishing professional articles or papers in architectural journals
- ENGAGING IN RELEVANT RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

LICENSEES SHOULD RETAIN DOCUMENTATION OF COMPLETED CE ACTIVITIES AS PROOF IN CASE OF AUDITS BY THE LICENSING BOARD.

RENEWAL APPLICATION PROCESS

THE RENEWAL APPLICATION PROCESS FOR INDIANA ARCHITECT LICENSES IS DESIGNED TO BE STRAIGHTFORWARD, ALLOWING ARCHITECTS TO SUBMIT THEIR DOCUMENTATION ONLINE OR VIA MAIL. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS IS ESSENTIAL FOR TIMELY PROCESSING.

SUBMISSION METHODS

FEES AND PAYMENT DETAILS

LATE RENEWAL AND REINSTATEMENT

GRACE PERIOD AND LATE FEES

Indiana may provide a short grace period after the expiration date during which renewal is still accepted with an additional late fee. The exact duration and fee amount are specified by the licensing board and should be verified annually.

REINSTATEMENT PROCEDURES
