The emerging global procurement strategy was understood as a chance to rethink the relocation of existing production facilities to profit from existing differences in price and performance as a resource-saving factor. Many companies tended towards a reduction of their vertical integration by outsourcing sections of their value chain. These contracted services of production result in higher transport volumes, increased complexity of supply processes and new requirements on logistic networks. This trend of outsourcing has not stopped, but is slowing down noticeably. Additionally, there is an increasing proportion of companies restoring business units that were outsourced before. Reasons for turning back decisions are often to be found in missed goals. It is not unusual that important cost factors were disregarded in the original basis of decision-making. In the meantime many companies have realized that it is easier to achieve stability of processes and therewith a control of costs by increasing their own contribution to production. Especially in times of under-utilized capacities like in the current crisis, insourcing can be a strategic option.
