For Small Groups Small groups allow for more in-depth sharing and vulnerability, so questions can be more personal and reflective.

- How do you feel God is guiding you right now?
- What spiritual lesson have you learned from a recent hardship?
- Describe a time when you experienced answered prayer.
- What area of your life do you want to surrender more fully to God?

Tips for Facilitating Icebreaker Questions Effectively
